Advanced Crime Prevention

Conference Description

The Advanced Crime Prevention Conference - 2012 is a three and a half day interactive training program designed specifically to address contemporary and timely crime prevention issues and topics. This conference is intended to provide both informative crime prevention knowledge and to provide participants with a forum to exchange information and ideas with other experienced crime prevention practitioners.

Who Should Attend

This conference is primarily intended for experienced crime prevention officers and specialists. Preferably, participants have worked in the area of crime prevention for at least two years and have attended a Basic Crime Prevention program. This requirement may be waived with documentation of an academic equivalent or extensive crime prevention experience.

What is Advanced Crime Prevention Conference - 2012

Crime prevention has played a vital role in the delivery of law enforcement services for decades. As we continue to evolve into the 21st century, however, new risks and threats will challenge the skills of crime prevention practitioners.

Crime in America is a dynamic phenomenon. Throughout most parts of the nation, crime rates are currently increasing. As society becomes increasingly sophisticated, technical and complex, so do the crime prevention issues faced by law enforcement and the community.

Some of these problems were virtually non-existent a decade or two ago. Advanced crime prevention issues include identity theft, the use of biometrics in crime prevention, the theft of laptop computers, cyber-crimes and numerous new frauds, scams, cons and schemes.

Crime prevention programs for senior citizens, the use of volunteers in crime prevention, house of worship crime prevention, "road rage", and using the Internet for crime prevention reflect timely issues which law enforcement must become increasingly involved.

Every public law enforcement agency should have a proactive crime prevention program that reflects the nation's current safety and security challenges.

Course Logistics

The cost of attending the Advanced Crime Prevention Conference - 2012 is \$295.00 for NYS CPC Members and \$345.00 for non-NYS CPC members. The conference will run from 1:00PM until 4:00PM on the 7th and from 8:00am until 4:00pm daily, concluding on Thursday.

If more than one person from the same agency attends the Conference, the cost for each participant is \$250.00 for NYS CPC members and \$300.00 for non-NYS CPC members

The registration fee includes conference materials, lunch and refreshment breaks during the conference.

The fee does not include travel, lodging or other food expenses except as indicated.

Lodging

Accommodations for the Conference are to be made by the attendees. Prior agreements have been made with the Millennium Hotel for a block of rooms. Make reservations at the Hotel by calling (716) 681-2400. The NYS CPC has booked rooms at the following rates for attendees: \$160.00 per night Single Occupancy or \$220.00 per night Double Occupancy. Rates include overnight accommodations, dinner, as well as breakfast the next morning. Each additional person in the same room, up to four per room, is an additional \$60.00 dollars. Taxes are not included, bring a tax exempt certificate if you are eligible.
